

Guest Safety Briefing

For the safety and enjoyment of Camp Guests, please inform Guests of the following information. (A Cahoots Adventure Camp Team Member will be more than happy to address Guests.)

SAFETY

Safety is the highest priority at Kerem Adventure Camp. Please follow all directions provided by your Camp Leaders and the Kerem Team.

- If sports equipment is caught in a tree, onto a roof, or under a Hut, please inform a Team Member and we will retrieve it for you.
- Please dismount bunks carefully and only use doorways for entering and exiting the Huts.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

- In the event of an emergency an alarm will be sounded as a sequence of three short, sharp blasts of a whistle, repeatedly (demonstrate).
- Please move quickly and calmly to the Primary Assembly Area on the lawn by the Volleyball Court and wait for further instructions.
- A Secondary Assembly Area is located in the car park and is only used when the Primary Assembly Area is inaccessible.

KEREM WILDLIFE

Kangaroos, snakes and ticks are common on the property at certain times of year.

- Kangaroos are wild animals please do not approach them
- Snakes are mainly active in the Spring and Summer months. If you see a snake please observe it from a safe distance and where possible, inform a Cahoots Adventure Camp Team Member who will attempt to remove it.
- In the unlikely event of snake bite, remain as still and calm as possible. Place maximum pressure on the wound and on the limb to slow the blood flow and send for help immediately
- Ticks are active all year around and are mainly found in areas of scrub, sand or garden beds. If you do find a tick attached to your body, avoid rubbing or pulling on it. Remain calm and see your First Aid Officer or a Kerem Team Member to have it removed safely.

EXCLUSION ZONES

• Please inform Guests of the below Exclusion Zones

Entry at Camp Leader's discretion;

- Swimming pool and pool enclosure (if booked)

- Low Ropes Course opposite car park
- Southern end of property past car park

No Entry at any time;

- Horse yards and stables located at the northern end of the lawn area and the paddock on the South-Western corner of the property
- Sheds beside office and the piggery in the North-Eastern corner of the property.
- Huts not in use by camp.
