



Guest Safety Briefing

For the safety and enjoyment of camp guests, please inform guests of the following information. (A Cahoots Adventure Camp team member is available to address guests if preferred.)

Safety

- Safety is the highest priority at Cahoots Adventure Camp. Please follow all directions provided by your Camp Leaders and Cahoots team members
- If sports equipment is caught in a tree, on a roof or under a building, please inform a Cahoots team member and we will retrieve it.
- Sports equipment is not to be used in the central camp area.
- Please dismount bunks carefully and use only the doorways for entering and exiting huts.

Emergency Evacuation

- In the event of an emergency an alarm will be sounded as a sequence of three short, sharp blasts of a whistle repeatedly.
- Please move quickly and calmly to the Emergency Assembly Area around the fire pit. In the case of a building fire, please move to the lawn at the end of the pool and wait for further instructions.

Kerem Wildlife

- Kangaroos, snakes and ticks are common on the property at different times of the year.
- Kangaroos are wild animals – please do not approach them.
- Snakes are mainly active in the spring and summer months. If you see a snake, observe it from a safe distance and where possible, inform a Cahoots Adventure Camp team member who will attempt to remove it.
- Ticks are active all year around and are found in areas of scrub, sand or garden beds. If you find a tick attached to your body, avoid rubbing or

- pulling on it. Remain calm and see your First Aid Officer or a Cahoots team member to have it removed safely.

Exclusion Zones

Please inform guests of the below Exclusion Zones

Entry at Group Co-ordinator's discretion:

- Swimming pool & pool enclosure (if booked)
- Bush areas surrounding main camp site (please wear enclosed shoes)
- Bush area at northern end of property

No entry unless supervised by a Cahoots Team Member:

- Within clearly marked climbing enclosures
- Southern end of property past The Climb Zone
- Maintenance/traffic area immediately north of Activity Hall

No entry at any time to:

- Horse yards and stables located at the northern end of the lawn area.
- Sheds in maintenance/traffic area.
- Huts not in use by camp.
